

## 2019 NightCrawler Gardens Specialty Peppers

*Capsicum chinense* (listed by heat):

- **Carolina Reaper:** 1,569,300-2,200,000 SHU. Current Guinness Record Holder. It is rumored that you can fry an egg on your tongue after eating one of these. Great flavor before the heat hits.
- **Chocolate Carolina Reaper:** 1,569,300-2,200,000 SHU. Chocolate strain from the same breeder as the original
- **Trinidad Moruga Scorpion** 1,200,000 – 2,000,000 SHU. The previous record holder, it starts fruity and heat builds up to scorching.
- **7 Pot Douglah** 923,000 – 1,853,396 SHU. Well known as the best flavor of the super hots, landrace variety from Trinidad.
- **Naga Viper** 1,382,118 SHU. 3-way hybrid from the UK, a rare plant considering that it's a former (brief) record holder.
- **7 Pot Barrackpore** 1,000,000 – 1,300,000 SHU. Larger 7 pot, fruity and heavy producer.
- **Dorset Naga** 544,000–1,221,000 SHU. Selection of the Naga Morich from the Dorset coast of England. Wonderful aroma.
- **Bhut Jolokia (Ghost)** 800,000 – 1,041,427 SHU. The pepper that started the craze.
- **Chocolate Bhut Jolokia (Chocolate Ghost)** 800,000 – 1,001,304 SHU. Natural variant of the Ghost but much sweeter.
- **Trinidad Sunrise Scorpion** 700,000-800,000 SHU. One of the most beautiful of the super hots, this one holds its fruit up in full view.
- **Red Savina** 200,000 – 580,000 SHU. A red habanero bred to be larger, heavier and hotter. Hottest pepper known from 1994-2006.
- **Fatalii** 125,000 – 325,000 SHU. From Central Africa, its citrus flavor is great on its own or in fruity halsas and sauces with pineapple or mango. Heat comparable to the habanero.

*Capsicum baccatum* plants

- **Aji Limon** (Lemon Drop) 15,000-30,000 SHU Strong lemon-lime flavored pepper which is a popular seasoning pepper in Peru, where it is known as qillu uchu. Heavy producer and quite ornamental in the landscape.

**SHU = Scoville heat units**
